

## **DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ANGLICAN WEDDINGS IN CYPRUS**

(Note : **Original** Documents to be shown to Chaplain at pre-wedding interview)

1. Completed Church marriage application form
2. Birth Certificates – preferably long version (Bride and Groom) and copy required for our records
3. Passports (Bride and Groom) and copy required for our records
4. Baptism Certificate(s) (at least one party must be a baptised Christian)
5. Certificate of freedom to marry - a statutory declaration of freedom to marry (or Certificate of No Impediment if resident in Scotland or Wales) dated and stamped by Embassy, Court or Solicitor as appropriate. Such documents are only valid for three months so to be dated within three months of date of wedding.
6. If divorced, **Originals** of final divorce papers – the **Decree Absolute**  
Note 1: this document will be kept by the Town Hall so if you wish to have a copy, please make a copy before your appointment at the Town Hall.  
Note 2: if bride is divorced and has reverted to her maiden name this must be stated in her statutory declaration
7. If widowed, **Originals** of death certificate and marriage certificate of deceased spouse
8. If adopted, an Adoption Certificate with solicitor's signature and official stamp
9. If under 18 years of age, a letter of consent from a parent or guardian
10. If name changed by Deed Poll, document from solicitor confirming change of name with solicitor's signature and official stamp
11. 2 witnesses – full names and passport numbers (and copies of passports for our file)
12. Form 'B' Licence (First Schedule Type B Section 6(1) the CERTIFICATE OF THE NOTICE AND FIXING DATE AND PLACE OF THE CELEBRATION OF MARRIAGE)
