A LITTLE HISTORY OF ST GEORGE IN THE FOREST

“Nearly 6,000 feet above the Mediterranean Sea stands the church of St George. Mount Troodos is an eastern spur of the Cyprian Olympus. Troodos itself is the hill-station of Cyprus and is reached in three hours by car from the capital, Nicosia. Here, among the pines, are the summer quarters of the Government, of the troops, and of many civilians. Visitors come from all parts of the Near East and from Egypt during the months June to October each year.”

These are the words that appeared on the front page of a leaflet introducing a history of St George in the Forest produced when the Church was consecrated in 1931. Since that date there has been a number of road changes, and the travelling time from Nicosia has been reduced from three hours to an hour and a quarter. The church has been used every summer by residents and visitors, also for a period it was the Garrison Church for the British base opposite, who have used it for services on two separate occasions in 2017.

St George is a part of the Anglican Cathedral in Nicosia, which itself is in communion with the Diocese of Cyprus and the Gulf. The services are conducted in English using Liturgy and Hymns that will be familiar to those used to attending Church of England services, But all denominations are very welcome.
